### Day 1

All is well and we know it best when we are obedient. What is most real is what we cannot even see. Why do you think that without faith, it is impossible to please God? Have you ever thought about the fact that you can't see God? Well, we get to know Him through the way He works in our lives- if we look. If we do not look for Him, we generally live in a dark oblivion- somehow existing without a true source for our lives. We feel disconnected, though, because we are more than certain that "Someone" or "Something" told us to hesitate for 5 seconds longer when that speeding car ran the red light right before our very eyes.

I should have named this one "I choose to obey God". I knew that some of you would be tempted not to finish the material if I told you what life was really all about before we got started. Now, let's get down to business. You are a captive if you are:

- enslaved to anyone or anybody other than Jesus Christ
- co-dependent
- led by emotions versus the Spirit of God (anger, depression, confusion, fear, etc.)
- not free to say, speak, think what you want depending on who you are around at the moment

Let's take a look at what God says about you. Let's see if you can see what He's saying. Please take a few moments to ask God for direction, read the following Scriptures and answer the questions in the space provided.

*Jeremiah 29:8-14 (NLT) 8The LORD Almighty, the God of Israel says, "Do not let the prophets and mediums who are there in Babylon trick you. 9Do not listen to their dreams because they prophesy lies in my name. I have not sent them," says the LORD. 10The truth is that you will be in Babylon for 70 years. But then I will come and do for you all the good things I have promised, and I will bring you home again. 11For I know the plans I have for you," says the LORD. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. 12In those days when you pray, I will listen. 13If you look for me in earnest, you will find me when you seek me. 14I will be found by you", says the LORD. "I will end your captivity and restore your fortunes. I will gather you out of the nations where I sent you and bring you home again to your own land."*

*Answer the following questions from your heart and prepare for wonderful things to happen as you submit to God's cleansing and healing power.*

1. What did God warn His people about in verse 8?
2. Why did He warn His people against listening to the prophets and mediums in Babylon (verse 9)?
3. According to verse 10, who knows best how long you will be in your particular situation? What words in that verse lead you to believe you have stumbled upon the right answer?
4. Have you ever had anyone to "speak into your life" with a false prophecy?
5. When you realized that the person had not heard from God, did you seek God for yourself or get depressed?
6. Are you still depressed about that? Would you like to know why or why not?

7. Describe the plans and thoughts the Lord has for you according to verse 11.
  
8. After you hear about how God feels about you, what should you do according to verse 13?
  
9. Would you like to take a moment to seek the Lord right now? Perhaps there's an area that you have not talked to Him about because you fear He won't understand or answer (excessive worry, racism, abortion, child molestation, rape, murder, forgery, emotional abuse, verbal abuse, mental abuse, physical abuse, sexual abuse toward and/or from husband, a break-up with a boyfriend, fornication, adultery, homosexuality, unrighteous anger, long held grudges, lukewarm heart in service, neglecting to share Christ with unbelievers- just to name a few). Write out a prayer of confession to God about what you are facing and what you need from Him right now. Use extra paper if necessary.
  
10. Just in case you are still wondering, what does verse 14 say God will do to you after you find Him?

Where is your Babylon? Is it in depression, outbursts of anger, crippling fear, excessive loneliness, false intimacy via pre-marital or extra-marital sexual acts or fantasies, substance abuse, child abuse, molestation, rape, profanity, self-righteousness, denial, pride, shame, guilt, unforgiveness, low to no self-esteem, bodily pain? Where is your Babylon? Why did God send you to Babylon? Was it that someone murdered your loved one and you have not chosen to forgive them? Was it that you were raised or neglected by mentally, physically, sexually, or emotionally abusive parents that you have chosen not to forgive? Is it some old boyfriend or ex-husband who rejected you without reasons justifiable to you that you have chosen not to forgive? Is it some substance abuse problem that you once had or still have that you will not let go of out of fear that there is nothing else to gratify your overwhelming emotions? Is it a towering boss or supervisor who has issues they refuse to deal with who take them out on you and you have chosen not to respond in mercy, grace, and love? Are you or were you that supervisor or boss? Are you feeling guilty about an abortion or molestation that you witnessed and/or participated in? Is it that unconfessed sin I have not listed? Is it that friend who rubs you the wrong way that you refuse to pray for anymore? Is it eating at you? Who is your prophet? Is it your pastor, a televangelist, a physic, a talk-show host, your best friend, a self-help book? Who is feeding your mind in Babylon?

Is it biblically sound? Is it consistent with the character of God?

Do you know?

How can you know? *2 Timothy 2:15 (KJV) Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.* That's how. If you're nearly as busy as I am, you might say, "Well, I don't have time to study the Bible like that". Sister, make time. This is your life we're talking about here. These are your children's lives. Make time. God wants to talk to you today.

Why did God tell Jeremiah to warn the people about the prophets and mediums? God knew that there would be nothing new under the sun. He knew that the same frenzy of prophesying into folks' lives that existed in Jeremiah's day would be the same stuff we got goin' on today. The only way someone can trick you is if you are unaware of reality. (By the way, I'm not at all saying that true prophesy does not exist. I'm just saying that there are two kinds of prophecy- true and false. I just want to remind you of that.)

God is giving us a reality check here. He wants us to know that Babylon is gonna last for a period of time. He knows how long it will last. He knows how you got there. He is in control of the hairs on your head. Don't you think He knows you're in Babylon? Your Babylon may change faces and shapes, but we all have them. We all have a Babylonian period to walk through. Some of us have plenty more than others. AND it's not always because we fell into a particular type of sin. It's just because we fell into sin period. The type is irrelevant. Sin is just sin. Some place more emphasis on sexual sin than any other type. . . It goes way, way deeper than that. Let's try pride. What about deception- self or otherwise? Ever heard of unforgiveness? Sexual sin is only a deed of the flesh. It's only what happens as a result of molded sin in the heart. Think about it. When you are truly satisfied with the Lord, is there honestly an overwhelming desire to sin in any way? No, of course not.

As far as sexual sin goes, is there an overwhelming desire to masturbate and/or indulge in any illicit sexual activity when you are at a point of satisfaction in your walk with the Lord? No. Why is that? There is true intimacy at the feet of Jesus. The intimacy we have with Him is much better than sex. Do you know why? Sex is just a vehicle to get you to that flash of intimacy you could experience at much longer lengths of time in the presence of God. Sin in any shape or form is just a vehicle to get you to spiritual, emotional, physical, and/or mental death. This may sound ludicrous to you if you have never truly experienced God's presence. 1-on-1. Unadulterated. Uninhibited. AND no, I'm not talking about speaking in tongues or jumping over pews (although you're at complete liberty to do either). I'm talking about a quiet place where God will meet you to caress and bathe your heart in forgiveness, grace, and everlasting love. There's nothing like it. I think I'll stop trying to explain it now because I'd much rather you put the book down at this point and ask God for many experiences like this. Experiencing the love of God is an invaluable gift. Books like this are great, but the Bible is infinitely better. (By the way, if I have been too graphic for you in this section, please try to understand. So many people are dealing with sexual sin without God's guidance because they believe God thinks they're disgusting. They do not yet realize that God hates the sin and

loves the sinner. Who knows? Maybe someone you know and love is dealing with these types of issues, but may be too afraid to share it with you. Let's have some compassion.)

God wants to bring us to a place that we recognize as home again. That would be in His presence. *Psalm 16:11 (NASB) You will make known to me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; In Your right hand there are pleasures forever.* Once we believe this, we will enter His presence. Once we enter His presence, we will know Him better. Once we know Him better, we will love Him better. The more we love Him, the more we will obey Him. Once we obey Him, we can confidently say **All is well**. Any child of a "decent" human parent can understand this principle. If a child obeys a decent parent, that child has no fear of punishment from that parent, but if that child disobeys, woe. Right?

God is a good Father. He loves me and cares for me. He knows who He is. He wants me to find out who He is so He can tell me who I am. After I know who I am, I'll know what I should do. The only way to spend time with God is to spend time with God. I have to talk to Him and listen to Him (through His Word, His Spirit, and other true believers in Christ Jesus). He is in control and He always will be- regardless of my circumstances. I believe He is who He says He is and that He will do what He says He will do.

What about you?

### Day 21

**I am not a failure.** I just messed up again. I am a learner. I did not learn the lesson prior to this test. I will be given this test again. It is within my purpose to pass it. I believe God has empowered me to pass this test. If I keep taking it, it will get easier and easier. The only way I can fail this test is not to take it. I have no choice but to pass. I am a successful sister in Christ.

I've always been one of those people who just beat myself up and beat myself up instead of building myself up, building myself up. The beating myself up was actually worse than whatever other sin I had actually committed. Isn't it a sin to do one of God's anointed harm? Well, I was sinning against myself when I was "being hard on myself". How dare I? Who gave me that right? No one gave me that right. I stole it. Trespass. Offense. Unauthorized transaction. Sin.

What's on the other side of sin? Obedience. Obedience waits patiently with blessings in her hands for those who turn away from sin. Many times, those of us who are perfectionists waste our time trying to reach an unattainable goal for the sake of avoiding ridicule. When ridicule happens anyway, we are crushed. Those of us who are lazy waste our time wasting our time and dreaming about the goals we could attain if only we'd work. Those two extremes should be kept away from as much as possible. The middle ground is to dream while attaining the goal and forgive those who ridicule you as you meet them, realizing that they only wish to have the gall with which to reach a goal. In other words, don't be distracted by the chatter. When we entertain the chatter, we are more susceptible to falling into sin. When we fall into sin, we fall into death. The death of a relationship . . . The death of a marriage . . . The death of a dream . . . The death of a destiny . . . Tragic at best.

Why even go there when we don't have to? Why not choose life? Don't you realize that the chatter can be your background music on the way to victory instead of the funeral dirge on the way to defeat? Don't you realize that it is not the chatter that distracts you but your very own negative response to it? Look at it differently. Try looking at it the way God would look at it. How? Let's pretend that you're God. And no, I'm not inviting you to blaspheme. Just try it. Ok. You're God, right? Now, let's say someone calls you stupid. What do you say? You might say, "You must not know me very well. I am the all-wise, all-knowing God who created the heavens and the earth in the beginning. My children are made in My image. Just look at one of them and you'll get a glimpse of Me. As a matter of fact, you can be one of My children, too. Only believe in My Son, Jesus. Would you like to try that now?" Then, let's say someone tells you that you don't exist. Your response might be, "Well, you must not be thinking clearly because if I didn't exist, you would not be discussing Me at all and you wouldn't be talking to Me either. Would you like to reconsider your beliefs now? I love you."

Based upon these conversations, does it seem as though God gets unnerved when someone accuses Him of something He didn't do? Well, I believe that He knows who He is and wants to show others who they are. He gets a lot of pleasure out of doing that. What about you? Do you get a lot of pleasure out of showing others who they are? If yes, praise God. If not, may I suggest that you may not be comfortable with who you are yet? Just imagine how many people would be stricken with the immediate wrath of God if He were not patient with

them as they used His name and words of profanity in the same sentence on a regular basis? If God was insecure in Himself, He'd be zapping and smashing folks left and right. IF some of us were God, that's exactly what we'd do. I know that because of the way I've observed myself and most people respond to insult and injury. Retaliation is usually the first instinct.

Our last resort is usually God. Sometimes, He's not a resort at all. Tragic. He knows who He is. As believers in Christ, He knows who we are and wants to tell us so we can be secure, but we won't listen. We won't pray. We won't read our Bibles. We won't refrain from things we already know are wrong in His sight. Yet, we wonder why we experience so much frustration and aggravation in our walk with Him. May I suggest that some of us are not walking with Him at all, but far far behind like a teenager who is ashamed to be seen with her father in the grocery store?

*If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels.”*  
(Mark 8:38 NIV)

So, at this point, you should be feeling the weight of reality. You should either feel light as a feather because none of the above applies to you or you should be bent over under the weight of the conviction of the Holy Spirit. Remember that it is your response that determines your destiny, not your circumstance. SO what's your response? Are you going to repent and ask for some help or are you gonna rot away in your pride and rebellion and confusion and shame and guilt and aloofness? The choice is yours.

Please choose God.

You can't lose unless you die without choosing God. Choose Him again and again. Choose Him for salvation. Choose Him for holiness. Choose Him for big decisions. Choose Him for small decisions. Just choose Him. He loves you and here's what He has to say about you . . .

You are not a failure. You just messed up again. You are a learner. You did not learn the lesson prior to this test. You will be given this test again. It is within My purpose that you pass it. Don't you believe that I have empowered you to pass this test? If you keep taking it, it will get easier and easier. Trust Me. (Abba Father, which art in heaven)

It is within my purpose to pass it. I believe God has empowered me to pass this test. If I keep taking it, it will get easier and easier. The only way I can fail this test is not to take it. I have no choice but to pass. **I am a successful sister in Christ.**

## CONCLUSION

When we see Jesus face-to-face, we will definitely be sure that it was nothing but His own grace, mercy, and infinite love that got us there. No one will be able to boast in His presence, although we sometimes steal that liberty now. No one will be able to condemn another in His presence because each one who believes on Him will stand redeemed and resurrected. No one will be able to resist His bidding because there will be no more bidding necessary. We shall be like Him just as He is. All things will be consummated. We shall know Him fully just as we are fully known. Can you see it? Keep seeking the Kingdom.

I suppose that by now you realize that a 21-day journey towards a more Christ-like mindset sometimes takes a lot longer than 21 days, huh?
