

During one¹ visit, I was so awestruck by the glorious light radiating from the Lord that the compunction to worship overwhelmed me. I fell face down on the sea of glass like crystal². I was curious about this enormous plane of spiritual substance, and my spirit whispered questions to the Lord about it.

“Holy! Lord, you are amazing. What is this vast sea that I am lying on made of?” I asked.

“What is the foundation of My Throne?” came the question back.

“Righteousness and justice, Lord?”

“And in what manner must you worship Me?” He asked

“In Spirit and Truth, Lord.”

“Yes, very good. What you are supported by here is righteousness and truth -- the very emanation of my Throne. It is pure and incorruptible. My sovereign reign over all that is, or ever will be, is supported by My righteousness and truth. Remember that while in my mortal body I said that I Am Truth. It is the substance of what the elders, and angels, and living creatures and all who come here stand on in their worship to Me. It is without end. You are able to stand on it as you embrace truth and receive righteousness in My Son, who has justified you because of My great mercy. The sea of glass also represents My steadfast mercy. My justice is supported by my infinite mercy, making My judgments righteous,” He explained gently.

“Thank you, Father. You are so good to me! It is clear like glass or crystal. What can I see through it, Lord?” I asked.

“It is not what you can see *through* it, but what you can see *in* it that matters” He said.

“I don’t understand, Lord. Please explain.”

“Put your face into the sea of glass” He said.

What was solid gave way as I pushed my face into it. It molded itself around my head as I pressed deeper in. I began to see and hear things in the substance. It was like a panoramic view of different visions, or doorways into other dimensions. I was able to choose from a myriad of visions displayed around me. As I focused upon one it would take on more detail.

I don't recall many details about the various visions and gateways I saw. The experience ended abruptly soon after I put my face into the sea of glass like crystal. This has happened during other heavenly voyages, where I am briefly introduced to something new, and then the experience ends suddenly. Sometimes I am taken back to further explore or understand what I got a glimpse of earlier. I think this was an initiatory experience and I am hoping that I will be given the opportunity to further explore the wonders that are in the sea of glass.

As I mentioned a little earlier, this experience actually occurred in parts. I have had this happen a number of times, where a visionary experience reoccurs and I am given more in the way of revelation about things already seen, or the vision takes on additional detail and depth.

It is a principle that once you have been to a certain place in the heavens you are able to return with greater ease. Now and again recalling in memory or talking about an experience can open the way to re-enter it, and sometimes to be taken further into it. But most of the time when I revisit a revelatory experience it is by the prompting of the Spirit. The Lord explained it to me this way:

“Once you have received something that is part of your inheritance in Me, you then possess it. As long as you remain within my Kingdom it remains yours. All that I give you here is everlasting and has eternal value. It is not disposable or for one time use. You become more practiced and skilled in the things I give you with their use. So, you must return to things opened up to you in order to mature and find the fullness of what I have for you in them. So it is with visions that are beyond simple prophecy.”

My initial thoughts on this experience are that the sea of glass did not actually lose its solid form, but I was being immersed, or baptized, into it. The foundation of the Lord's Throne is immovable and solid. But we can be immersed into mercy and truth. Looking deep into the truth (that is the Lord who is Truth) comes as we plunge deeper into the revelation of our right relationship with Him and then embrace and live by the truth that we are given. Greater dimensions of revelation in truth and advancement in righteousness are opened up to us as we look intently into these things and come into conformity with what we see there.

The foundation of God's Throne is righteousness and justice. The sea of glass is perfectly peaceful and a symbol of His truth and mercy. Because He has made truth available without limit in His mercy, His judgments are righteous. His authority and rule are based on absolute truth, justice, mercy and right action in every regard, without fail. Eternal perfect peace, tranquility, and clarity are the results of living in accordance with these things.
